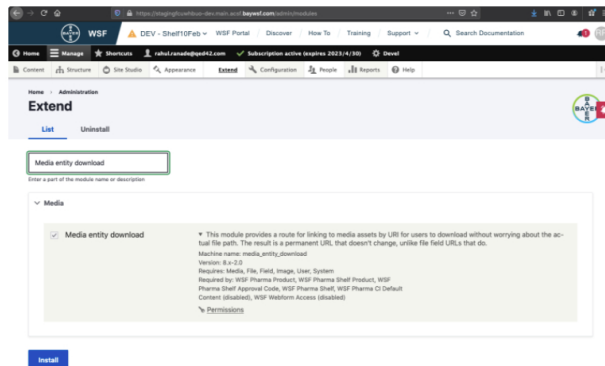

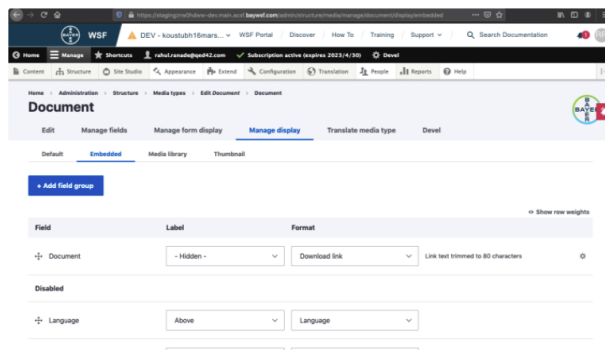
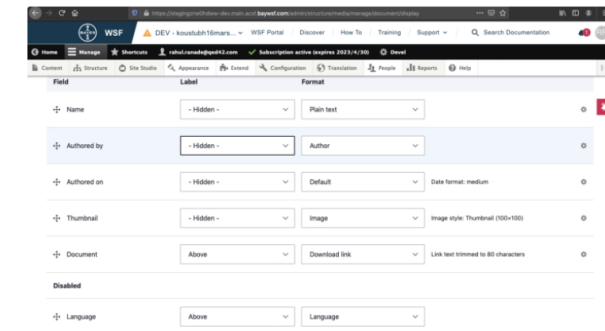
Module install

- Login into the site as a Site Configurator user role
- Visit Extend (.../admin/modules), and install the **Media entity download** module.



Field Format for Document field

- Log in as Administrator user role.
- Navigate to /admin/structure/media/manage/document/display
- verify that the field format is 'Download Link' for field document in both default and embedded tabs.

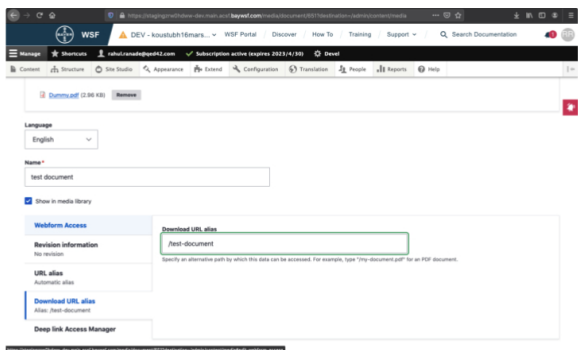

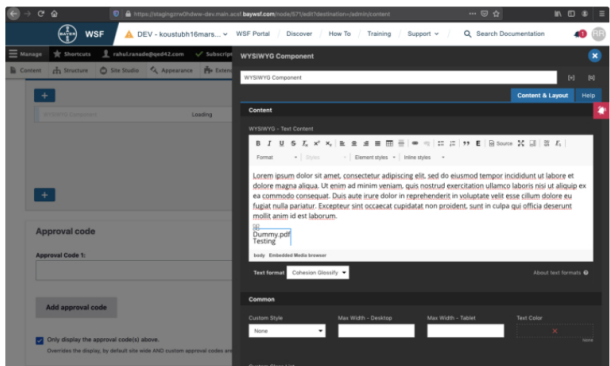

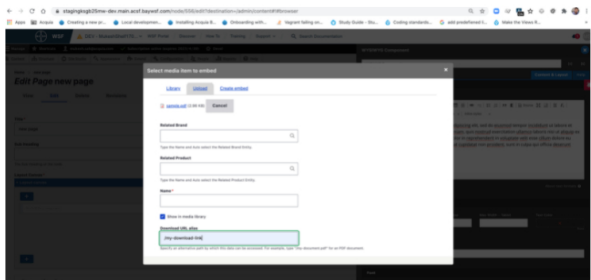
- Log in as **Administrator/Content Manager/Content Editor** user.
- Navigate to **/media/add/document**
- Navigate to Document field and upload the document file.
- Add url alias for document file in the field **Download URL alias**



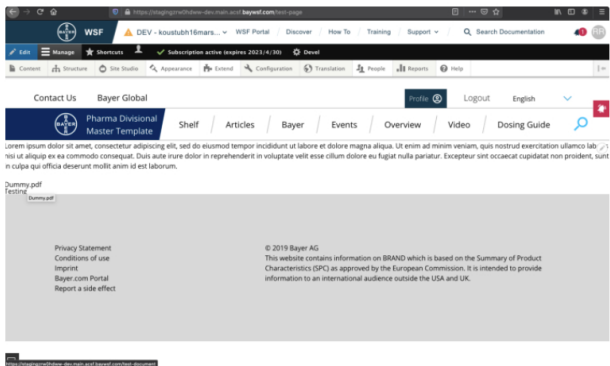
- Create a page content and place the same media using **Media browser** tool in WYSIWYG editor and save it.



- We can upload new Document file using **Media browser** tool in WYSIWYG editor like below.



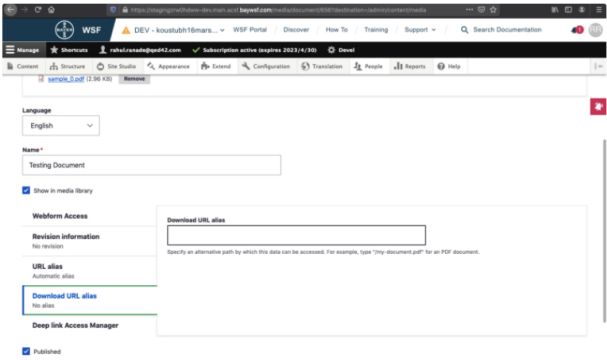
- View the page content and verify that the document link should be displayed as **Download URL alias** if alias url is added in media file.



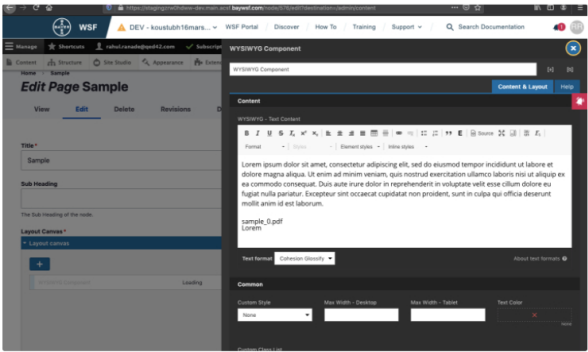
Adding/Uploading media without Download URL alias

- Log in as **Administrator/Content Manager/Content Editor** user.
- Navinate to **/media/add/document**

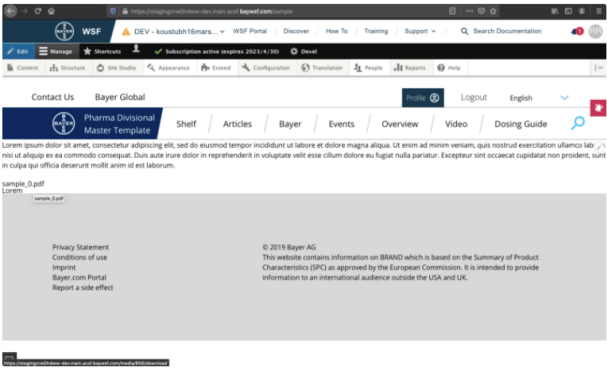
- Navigate to Document field and upload the document file.
- Leave empty field **Download URL alias**



- Create a page content and place the same media using **Media browser** tool in WYSIWYG editor and save it.



- View the page content and verify that if **Download URL alias** is not added in media file then document link should be displayed as media/{id}/download by default.



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
